History unearthed at “Linnwood”

Visit this hidden gem in Sydney's south west on Sunday 27th April. "Linnwood" is a gentleman's country retreat built in 1891 and sits on 5 hectares at Guildford. As well as viewing new displays at the property, visitors can enjoy a delicious Devonshire tea. Ample free onsite parking.

The Friends of Linnwood have unearthed items from the Collection especially for the Australian Heritage Festival event, including:
